Message from the Headteacher

Many of your children would have had the pleasure of been taught by Mrs Crossley in our Nursery. Mrs Crossley has been on sabbatical this year so she could spend more time with her young family. Very sadly for us Mrs Crossley has decided not to return to Stoughton in September after 9 years of loyal service. I'm sure you'll join us in wishing her all the best and thanking her for all that she has done for the children and families at Stoughton.

I took part in some interesting training about managing online reputations and about being safe online. Social media and school websites are a invaluable communication tool in our digital world. The staff here endeavour to share as much as we can online and as quickly as we can but the teaching, assessment and care of the children comes before a post online. For us there are checks to do before we publish any photos, we have to check that each child has permission to be on the web. If families haven't returned this information to us, we have to make the assumption that you don't wish for your child's photo to go online. So please do bear with us, if we have forgotten to post an event or have been a bit slower than expected. We have also found that sometimes, every photo has a child in who doesn't have permission and then we can't post at all. We want our social media to be a place to celebrate what is happening in school, and to give you an insight to some of the things that go on during the school day.

All year groups have now taken part in the Guildford and Godalming Confederation Sportshall Athletics at the Spectrum. The children did us proud with their excellent behaviour, manners and sportsmanship. Over their time at Stoughton all children will be offered the opportunity to take part in this fun event.

This week has been Science Week - the children have had a fabulous time planning, experimenting, investigating and visiting the Science Dome on Monday (thanks to the Friends for funding this). All children have enjoyed whole class Forest School sessions this week too. The Year 2 children have planned science experiments for children in Nursery, Reception and Year 1 to try this afternoon. It will be great to see the Year 2 children in the role of teacher!


