Headteacher's Message

We are rapidly approaching the end of the school year and in some ways, it really doesn't feel like the end of term - no sports day, leavers or class assemblies or summer fair but in others it definitely does! The preparations for the next academic year are in full swing and we are working hard to make a workable and safe plan for September for all. The government released new guidance for schools of July 2nd for which we need to follow for September. We will be fully updating our risk assessment and our risk control statement in readiness for September. I will be writing to you all again next week more details for what September will look like after the governing body and Athena Schools Trust have signed off the risk documents.

I can't thank the school community enough for the support through this most challenging of times, it's really appreciated. For those of you with children still learning at home I know it can be really hard, especially in these latter weeks and motivation and enthusiasm is waning. It definitely is in my own home too, with my daughters pushing their Dad's buttons more frequently, whilst he's trying to juggle home schooling and working!

This morning you will receive a brief end of year report from your child's class teacher, this will be emailed to you via ParentMail. You'll notice that the reports don't have any gradings included due to us not being in a position assess the children fully and accurately. If you have any queries or comments regarding your child's report or you wish to speak to your child's class teacher, please email them directly to arrange this. You'll also receive instructions on how to download your child's Tapestry profile very soon.

At the end school year, we like to gather feedback of the parent community. Your views are really important in helping us to grow and improve. The link to the anonymous survey is here and I will also send it separately via ParentMail.

A polite reminder to any parents who have children starting in reception or nursery in September that all the information you require is on the school website here. It is really important that we have the admissions and permissions form submitted ASAP.

A little plea from the Year 1 team. Do any of you have any small world toys at home that your children no longer play with and you'd be willing to donate to the school? Donations can be brought to the school. We'll have a donation box which we wont touch for 72 hours after the donations have come in.




Other Information

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are pleased to announce that we can offer holiday camps this summer. As of the 19th June, the DIE released a further statement to allow holiday camps to open.

We will continue to review Government guidance in relation to holiday careps, to en-sure a safe experience for all children and staff. The Government will release further guidance on how measurements will be implemented but for now, we are only able to take week only bookings (Mon-Fri). We are unable to take individual day bookings so that we can keep children in groups/bubbles for the week they are with us.
