<b>Autumn 1</b>	<p><b>Belonging - Who am I, and where do I belong?</b> That every person is special and unique</p> <p>That some people believe God made them this way.</p> <p>How new babies are welcomed</p> <p>That people belong together in different ways.</p> <p>That religious people have different ways of showing they 'belong' together</p> <p>About special people in different religions (e.g. Jesus/Muhammad/Moses)</p> <p><b>Celebration-</b> Harvest</p> <p><b>The specialness</b> of Autumn (What makes our world wonderful)</p>	<p><b>Christianity - What do Christians believe God is like?</b></p> <p>That people sometimes use pictures to convey meaning</p> <p>That there are many different images of God contained within the Bible</p> <p>That these images help to answer the question 'What is God like?'</p> <p>That Christian beliefs about God are connected with these images</p> <p>That Christians believe that God loves them, and all people</p> <p>To express their own thoughts and ideas about what God might be like</p>	<p><b>Christianity - Why is the Bible an important book for Christians?</b></p> <p>That books can be special/important to people</p> <p>That the Bible contains 'stories' about God and people</p> <p>About some key narratives from the Old Testament e.g. Jacob, Joseph, Moses, Joshua, David, Samuel, Daniel etc.</p> <p>That the New Testament contains accounts from the life of Jesus &amp; the early Church</p> <p>That Christians read the Bible to learn about God and that this affects how they live their lives</p>

<p><b>Autumn 2</b></p>	<p><b>Celebration - Why do we have celebrations?</b></p> <p>Each person has a “birth-day” and this is celebrated on the day s/he was born</p> <p>Celebrations are joyful times</p> <p>A celebration is often a time to say thank you</p> <p>That Christians celebrate special festivals-Harvest and Christmas</p> <p>That other religions have different festivals-Diwali</p>	<p><b>Christianity - Why is Christmas important to Christians?</b></p> <p>That Christmas is linked to the account of the birth of Jesus</p> <p>About the key people and events in the birth stories (Nativity)</p> <p>That this story is the focus of the celebration for Christians</p> <p>That Christians believe Jesus is the Son of God</p>	<p><b>Christianity - What does the Christmas story tell Christians about Jesus?</b></p> <p>That Christmas is the celebration of Jesus’ birth</p> <p>That Christians believe there are clues in the story that show who Jesus is</p> <p>What these clues show:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● star – the birth of a new King</li> <li>● presents – Jesus as God’s gift to the world and the gifts of the Magi</li> <li>● angels – messengers from God who told people about Jesus being God’s Son</li> <li>● light – Jesus as the light of the world.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Spring 1</b></p>	<p><b>Specialness &amp; Celebration-</b> Chinese New Year.</p> <p><b>What makes something special?</b> That different things are special to people for different reasons.</p> <p>How to look after special things and respect things that are special to others.</p> <p>People can use objects to help them remember special times and places.</p> <p>That memories can be special That some objects are ‘religious’ objects and help people think about God.</p>	<p><b>Christianity - Who is Jesus?</b></p> <p>That Christians call Jesus the ‘Son of God’</p> <p>That Christians believe that Jesus is both human and divine (God)</p> <p>About the main events in Jesus’ life</p> <p>That Jesus performed miracles, including healings e.g. water into wine; feeding the 5000; calming the storm; Bartimaeus; the paralysed man; the sick girl; the ten lepers</p>	<p><b>Christianity - Why is Church important to Christians?</b></p> <p>That Christians meet together in a church</p> <p>That the church is not just a building but also a family of Christian people that Christians show God is important to them through worship</p> <p>That there are special Christian symbols in a church building</p> <p>About the main features of a church (interior / exterior)</p>

		<p>That many people followed Jesus, and still do now</p> <p><b>Why did Jesus tell parables?</b> That stories can teach people things</p> <p>The Bible contains <u>parables</u> that Jesus told</p> <p>Jesus' parables are found in the New Testament</p> <p>Parables have a deep meaning</p> <p>That Jesus told parables to explain important truths to people</p> <p>That the truths in Jesus' parables have an impact on a Christian's life</p>	
<p><b>Spring 2</b></p>	<p><b>Specialness &amp; Celebration -</b> Celebrating Easter(Christianity) St. David's day and St. Patrick's day</p> <p><b>What makes a place special?</b> That some people have places that are special to them</p> <p>That there are special buildings where some people go to think and learn about God</p> <p>That some people feel close to God anywhere or in their own special places.</p> <p>Jesus-a special person for Christians</p>	<p><b>Christianity - What do eggs have to do with Easter?</b> That new life is an important theme of Easter celebrations</p> <p>On Good Friday Christians remember Jesus' death</p> <p>On Easter Day Christians celebrate Jesus' resurrection</p>	<p><b>Christianity - Why do Christians call Jesus 'Saviour'?</b> That friendship is an important value</p> <p>The Bible contains stories about people Jesus met and 'rescued'</p> <p>That many people's lives were changed by meeting Jesus</p> <p>That Christians call Jesus 'Saviour'</p> <p><b>Why is Easter important to Christians?</b></p>

	Celebrating	That symbols are used to represent key aspects of Easter: hot cross buns – Good Friday / the crucifixion Easter eggs – the Garden Tomb; new life; the resurrection	That friendship is a precious thing and can get damaged That Christians believe that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● God loves all people and wants to be their friend</li><li>● The things they do wrong damage their friendship with God</li><li>● Jesus' death means they can put things right with God again (be forgiven)</li><li>● Jesus' resurrection means that death is not the end</li></ul>

<p><b>Summer 1</b></p>	<p><b>Specialness - What can we learn from stories?</b>          That people can have favourite stories.</p> <p>That through stories people share ideas and values about how to live          That some books are special to religious groups, e.g. Bible (Christians) Torah (Jews) Qur'an (Muslims)</p> <p>That some stories are about special people e.g. Jesus, Muhammad-pbuh, and Moses etc.</p> <p><b>Celebration-</b> St. George's day</p>	<p><b>Judaism - What is the Torah, and why is it important to Jews?</b>          What it means to treat something with respect</p> <p>The Torah is the Jewish holy book and contains rules for Jews to live by</p> <p>The Torah is in the form of a scroll and is written in Hebrew</p> <p>The Torah can also be found in the Old Testament section of the Bible</p> <p>The synagogue is the place where Jews go to learn, worship God and be together as a community, and is where the Torah is kept</p> <p>Light is a symbol for God's presence in the synagogue</p>	<p><b>Islam - Who is Allah, and how do Muslims worship him?</b>          That Muslims believe in one God, Allah</p> <p>that Allah:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• is the Arabic name for God the Creator</li> <li>• has ninety-nine beautiful names that reflect aspects of his character</li> </ul> <p>that Muslims believe that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• any thought or action can be a prayer</li> <li>• they should be ritually clean** before they pray and can pray anywhere as long as it is clean</li> <li>• they should face Makkah when they pray</li> <li>• different physical positions in prayer help them focus on Allah</li> </ul>

<p><b>Summer 2</b></p>	<p><b>Specialness &amp; Belonging -</b></p> <p>What makes our world wonderful?</p> <p>Our world is a place of wonder.</p> <p>People are naturally 'creative'</p> <p>That some people believe our world was created by God and that this is a special story in their special books.</p> <p>That we should look after our world</p>	<p><b>Judaism - Why do Jewish families celebrate Shabbat?</b></p> <p>That families celebrate special times in many different ways</p> <p>That Shabbat and the Friday night meal are an important part of Jewish family life and help Jewish families to feel closer to God</p> <p>Shabbat lasts from sunset on Friday to sunset on Saturday, and that there are symbols that mark its beginning and its end</p> <p>Shabbat is a time of rest and recalls how God rested on the seventh day after creation</p>	<p><b>Islam - What is important to Muslim families?</b></p> <p>That the word 'Islam' means 'peace' in Arabic</p> <p>That 'respect' is important to Muslims</p> <p>That Muslims believe that Muhammad (pbuh*):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• is a prophet and the last messenger of Allah in Islam</li> <li>• is the best example of a Muslim, and that they should try to be like him</li> </ul> <p>That the Qur'an:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• is the special book for Muslims and is written in Arabic</li> <li>• contains the holy words of Allah to Muhammad</li> </ul>
